- In 1981, he founded the domestic abuse services for Wilder Foundation in St. Paul

- Been in the schools doing anti-bullying work with middle school youth as well as facilitating groups for adolescents
- Co-facilitated children’s domestic abuse groups for ages 4-12 who have witnessed violence in the home or who have been abused

Mike is in private practice where he continues to facilitate groups for perpetrators and victims. He conducts workshops & trainings as well as providing clinical consultation and supervision.
